Club Information

All of our Centre information can be found on our website which is updated as regularly as possible with news and important messages but please see additional places below where information can be viewed.

Tee Times & Reservations: Members can book their tee time up to 21 days in advance (non-members 14 days), this can be done online (preferred option) or in the golf shop. Members must be aware that non-members (pay and play / societies) are just as important and are a necessary income for the Golf Centre, and need to be made welcome, as it subsides yearly membership subscriptions. Here at the Golf Centre, we operate a booking system where you book your tee time in advance where you turn up on the designated day and time. You can just turn up and see what availability there is, but there is no guarantee we can get you out. But will do our best to do so where possible.

Email Newsletter: The Centre send out regular newsletters keeping you up to date with golf news, local and global, golf tips and improvement ideas, offers and any upcoming events. To receive these emails, contact us and we'll get you signed up. provide your details to us and we can add you immediately.

Noticeboards: Notices will be located either in the shop or by the driving range machine. Some notices are their for-information others for promotions.

What do you need to play Golf?

Clothing: We don't have a strict dress code here as we aim to stay as inclusive as possible. The only requirement is flat shoes and clothes to be worn! No high heels or studded shoes etc which could damage the course. However if playing in a club competition we would encourage a slightly smarter 'golfing attire' but again not a must. Golf shoes are preferred as they offer you better grip and can be waterproof.

What should be in your golf bag?

Here is a selection of equipment you may benefit from having in your bag:

Up to 14 clubs – We prefer every golfer to have their own set as it makes the round flow better, although it is not a must have requirement. Hire clubs available also from the shop.

Towel to clean the club / club cleaner

Umbrella / waterproofs / hat / gloves

Ball marker and pitch repair tools – Repairing pitch marks is essential to help keep green quality

Golf balls and golf tees – enough to complete your round!

Scorecard and pencil – some apps on your phone can now do this.

Water and snacks to stay hydrated and focused.

A mobile phone only to be used for medical emergencies or to contact the golf shop.

Benefits of Being a Club Member

UNLIMITED GOLF – If you are a GOLD member then you can play as much golf as you wish (subject to tee time availability)

Good for your health – A round of golf typically works off just over 1000 calories (18 holes) and social interaction is proven to increase life expectancy.

Discounted Lessons – By becoming a member you get discount for yourself on lesson packages.

Sense of belonging- We actively encourage and create opportunities for you to play with new people. Find social groups who meet your needs and demands and feel part of a club which supports you. Handicaps. Wessex is a World Handicap System registered course, affiliated to both England and Dorset Golf Unions.

If you already have a handicap, your round at the Wessex can be submitted.

Benefit of getting your official handicap, it enables you to play in 'Open' competitions, club comps, leagues and alliances. When playing other courses, you may be required to show proof of an official handicap.

It is not essential to have a handicap at the Wessex.
